The Company has established an annual dollar limit of \$2,500 per individual on gifts, promotional materials, or items or activities provided to covered medical or healthcare professionals as defined under California Law. This dollar limit is a maximum only and does not necessarily represent a typical, average, usual, or customary amount.

To the best of its knowledge and based upon a good faith understanding of the statutory requirements of the California Act, ScPharma declares that it is in compliance with its Comprehensive Compliance Program.

ScPharma has tailored its Comprehensive Compliance Program to meet the specific needs of the Company and to detect violations and ensure that instances of alleged improper conduct are properly reviewed and addressed. ScPharma regularly assesses the effectiveness of its Program.
